Potter Park Field Trip

We will be visiting Potter Park Zoo in Lansing on Monday May 20, 2019 . **All classes will go on this day!** We will be meeting at the zoo entrance for check in at 10:15A.M. **You will not go through the regular entrance.** There is a special entrance to the right for us. Morning classes will attend a program at 11:30. Afternoon classes will attend a program at 12:00. After you check in with us, you may wander the park, until your program time. We will direct you to the correct building for the program.

The cost of \$5.00 **per person, (adults & children)** includes park entrance and entrance to a program about animals. Children 2 and under are free. We are going through the Docents, so there will be no passes excepted. There is a \$5.00 parking fee per car, so car pooling is advised! (Parking fee to be paid at the park) Money for program and entrance, is due by Thursday, May 16th. Pay by check only, made out to HCEC. There will be **no refunds**. Siblings are welcome. Bring a sack lunch as there are picnic tables and benches available to eat when you'd like. There is also a concession stand located on site. We will go no matter what the weather, so plan to dress accordingly!
